8. RESOLUTION 16-14

Austin McGuigan, Community Development Director, presented Resolution 16-14. Austin explained that the City of Salem is in need of transportation improvements (third bridge) that require an 35.7 acre UGB expansion with a coordinated process and accelerated timeline. Austin recommends accommodating the request and waiving the UGB expansion fee due to the request being in the public interest and public benefit, according to Polk County's Comprehensive Plan, and additionally, Polk County is a cooperating partner on the third bridge project. If approved, the City of Salem will send a joint notice to the Department of Land Conservation and Development of a joint public hearing on October 4 with the Cities of Salem and Keizer, Marion and Polk Counties, and local jurisdictions Planning Commissioners to hear testimony on the UGB expansion.
