RULES AND REGULATIONS ALL GENERAL RULES APPLY

- 1. The Photography Division is open to persons 5 years of age and older in classifications appropriate for the age of the entrant (ages 5-12, 13-17. 18 and older.)
- 2. Entry is open to novice, amateurs and professionals, but novice, amateurs and professionals are judged separately. Novice will receive competitive judging based on new to photography. Amateurs will receive a
 - competitive judging based on a more skilled level; Professionals will receive a qualitative judging. Professionals include teachers, judges, instructors, advisors, owners/operators/demonstrators engaged in business related to the production of photography, as well as those who create such items for profit. If entering Novice add "N" after the lot number. If Amateurs add "A" after lot number, as a professional, add a "P" after the lot number (Example: Lot 101-P).

Professional—The definition of Professional is \$5000 or more entries will be accepted for display only. Ribbons will be awarded on the basis of merit only and no other award will be made.

- 3. No article that has been exhibited previously at Polk County Fair will be allowed to be entered.
- 4. All exhibits must remain in place and intact until 9:30am Sunday August 11th, 2024.
- **5.** All exhibits must have been made solely by the person under whose name they are entered. Copies of other people's work are not allowed
- 6. Only one entry in each lot is allowed
- 7. Judges' decisions are final.
- 8. Any entry deemed by the Superintendent to be inappropriate for public display may be rejected by that Superintendent. Pornographic or sexually-explicit materials will be rejected.
- Polk County Fair will not be responsible for theft or breakage of any exhibit.

PHOTOGRAPHY SPECIFIC RULES

- 1. A MAXIMUM OF FIFTEEN (15) PHOTOGRAPHS MAY BE SUB MITTED BY ANY ONE EXHIBITOR. Each photograph in the Distinguished Amateur Photographer competition will be counted toward the fifteen photograph limit.
- 2. Photographs may not have watermarks or signatures
- 3. Mounting & Matting
 - A. Photographs may be matted or unmatted
 - B. Photographs must be mounted on rigid backing. 3/16 inch foam board or 4-ply mount board is ideal. Construction paper mounts will not be accepted. Use spray glue to adhere photos to the backing.
 - C. Framed photographs, those under glass and canvas or metal prints will not be accepted.
 - D. Do not put hanging devices on back of photos
- 4. Size Limits
 - A. Photographs, including matting may not be larger than 12"x16". (See exception below)
 - B. Photographs, including matting must be at least 8" in the small er dimension. (Note that larger photographs display better, entrants are encouraged to enter their photos as large as possible within the limits.)
 - C. Panoramas should be no smaller than 4"x12" and no larger than 12"x48". Panoramas may be horizontal or vertical
- Requirements for entries in the Distinguished Amateur Photographer category
 - A. This competition is open to entrants in the Adult Photographer category
 - B. 6 photos should be entered. 3 must be color and 3 must be monochrome.
 - C. On the entry tag for each photograph, mark "DA" after the lot number. Example: Lot number 101-DA
 - D. Winner of the Distinguished Amateur competition from the previous year is ineligible to enter in the present competition
- 6. Entries will be judged on subject matter, impact, composition, lighting, print quality, originality, and presentation.
- 7. The work of young photographers will be judged separately from that of adult photographers. Young photographer's entries are in Classes 64 & 65
