## POLK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TUESDAY MEETING MINUTES October 3, 2017

- 1. At 9:00 a.m., Commissioner Pope declared the Tuesday meeting of the Polk County Board of Commissioners in session. Commissioner Ainsworth and Commissioner Wheeler were present.
- 2. <u>MINUTES</u> COMMISSIONER AINSWORTH MOVED, COMMISSIONER WHEELER SECONDED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 26, 2017.

3. <u>SHERIFF'S OFFICE UPDATE</u> – Sheriff Garton presented the Mobile Crisis Response Team stats for the months of June, July and August. There were 205 calls received, 11% were remanded to the jail, and 37% were taken to a mental health facility. The board requested data on recidivism/repeat callers in future reports. The Sheriff is working with local cities on uniform data tracking for more accurate grant reporting. Staff is also working to develop a more thorough reporting document that will better organize data, Department goals, assignments, etc.

The Sheriff office has a new practicum student from Western working in the office.

4. <u>DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY</u> – Todd Whitaker, Public Works Director, presented a memo to declare 2007 Crown Victoria, S0701, as surplus property.

## BY CONSENSUS, THE BOARD DELACRED S0701 AS SURPLUS PROPERTY.

The Board directed staff to draft modifications to the procurement policy to allow Department Heads to declare surplus property up to a value of \$3,000. These modifications will be presented at a future board meeting.

5. <u>RECLASSIFICATION OF A FISCAL ANALYST I</u> – Matt Hawkins, Administrative Services Director, presented a memo requesting the reclassification of Ryan Batacandolo from a Fiscal Analyst I to a Fiscal Analyst II in the Health Services Department. The effective date for the reclassification is October 1, 2017, and has a 12-month fiscal impact of approximately \$2,500.

## BY CONSENSUS, THE BOARD APPROVED THE RECLASSIFICATION.
