3. NEW JOB SPEC, SALARY RANGE, & RECLASS

Matt Hawkins, Administrative Services Director, tells the Board he is requesting a new job specification, salary range, and a reclassification. He is recommending the new job specification of Cartographic Deed Specialist II be adopted by the Board along with this he is requesting a reclassification of our current Cartographic Deed Specialist I. Amy Everetts is in that position now and he is also requesting that she be reclassified into this new position. Amy has taken on handling all of the manufactured structures from the building codes division. If these changes are approved the fiscal impact would be approximately \$2,600 including PERS contributions should this have been for a 12 month period this fiscal year.

She is working with the IT department to get the Appraisers set up with laptops that can remote in to the network so they can do work from home after they are done with the online training.
