## **DEPARTMENT HEAD UPDATE:**

Valerie Patoine, County Assessor, stated that Polk County has roughly 37,000 taxable and nontaxable accounts. The 2021 real market value is 12.8 billion of taxable property which is a 9% growth from 2020. The 2021 assessed value is 7.08 billion of taxable property which is a 4.5% growth from 2020. The total taxes and fees levied for 2021 was 111,2 million which was a 5% growth from 2020. Mrs. Patoine estimates there with be a 5% growth for assessed value in 2022. She then gave an overview of her office and the work that they are responsible for.

8. NEW JOB SPECIFICATION, SALARY AND RECLASSIFICATION OF AN EMPLOYEE

Matt Hawkins, Administrative Service Director, requested the adoption of a new job specification for a Resource Center Coordinator within Family Community Outreach department. Along with the creation of the position Mr. Hawkins is requesting the reclassification an employee from Lead Resource Connector to Resource Center Coordinator. This would be effective February 1, 2022 with an increase of \$3300.00 including PERS.
