3: ORRS CORNER RD/CLOW CORNER RD UPDATE:

Kumar Rethnesamy, ODOT, provided an update to the Board of Commissioners and staff regarding the closure of Orrs Corner Rd & Clow Corner Rd. Mr. Rethnasamy went over a memo addressed to the Board with the purpose to follow up on the concerns that were raised at the BOC meeting on 9/27/2022, as well as, a memo from Todd Whitaker, Public Works Director, dated 10/4/2022. Mr. Rethnasamy went over the changes that have been made to these plans after receiving feedback from Polk County, local EMS providers, and local farmers. Commissioner Pope asked for some additional information about Orrs Corner Rd. Commissioner Gordon stated that he appreciates their willingness to take feedback and make these changes and he recommends that ODOT continues reaching out to people on future projects to continue to get their feedback and engagement. Commissioner Mordhorst thanked Kumar for all of his hard work on this and for being willing to take feedback.

SUBJECT: Temporary Closure of Clow Corner Rd During Construction of State Project

Tuesday Board Meeting

11/29/2022

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the temporary closure of Clow Corner Road during certain periods of construction of project currently known as K21374 OR99W_Orrs Corner Rd – Clow Corner Rd (Clow/99W Project).

ISSUE:

Shall the County approve the temporary closure of Clow Corner Road as requested by the Oregon Department of Transportation to facilitate construction of various phases of the Clow/99W Project.

DISCUSSION:

The Oregon Department of Transportation is currently in the final design phase of a project that will construct road improvements to OR 99W to address safety and crash history problems at the Clow Corner Road intersection and improve safety at the Orrs Corner Road intersection.

As part of this project, ODOT will be constructing an offset roundabout on the east side of the current OR 99W alignment. The nature of the project will require Clow Corner Road to be closed in two locations – one east of OR 99W at the east end of the construction zone and one on the west side of OR 99W, between Riddell Rd and the construction zone.

The anticipated duration of the east side closure is 5 months, during which time local traffic will be diverted eastbound on Clow Corner Road and Rogers Road to OR 51. The timing of the closure is anticipated to be between January 1 and June 30. The specific dates of the closure will be updated at least 30 days prior to the closure. The anticipated duration of the west side closure is 2 months, during which time local traffic will be diverted south on Riddell Rd to Hoffman Road, or north on Riddell Rd to Orrs Corner Rd. The timing of the closure is anticipated to be between July 1 and

November 30. The specific dates of the closure will be updated at least 30 days prior to the closure.

FISCAL IMPACT:
There is no fiscal impact of this closure to the County.
