POLK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TUESDAY MEETING – OCTOBER 25, 2011 MINUTES

- At 9:05 a.m., Chairman Pope declared the Tuesday meeting of the Polk County Board of Commissioners in session. Commissioner Ainsworth and Commissioner Wheeler were present.
- 2. MOTION: COMMISSIONER AINSWORTH MOVED, COMMISSIONER WHEELER SECONDED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF OCTOBER 18, 2011.

MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

3. POLK COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH'S COMMUNITY HEALTH ASSESSMENT LAUNCH
Randi Phillips, Public Health Supervisor informed the Board that the Public Health
Department received a grant from the State of Oregon to work on readiness activities
that will apply toward Public Health National Accreditation. There are 10 counties in
Oregon that received this grant.

The 2009 community health assessment has been updated for 2011, and is a comprehensive assessment of health indicators, demographics, chronic disease, and economic factors that impact overall health in Polk County. This health assessment is a requirement of the National Accreditation. In order to get this information out to the community, Polk County Public Health has partnered with Salem Health to host a Community Health Assessment Launch lunch on October 31, 2011 from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the Community Corrections meeting room.

4. <u>APPOINTMENTS TO MID-WILLAMETTE VALLEY AREA COMMISSION ON TRANSPORTATION</u>

Chairman Craig Pope informed the Board that the terms of Craig Pope and Val Adamson, who are the Polk County representatives to the Mid-Willamette Valley Area Commission on Transportation will be expiring in December.
