POLK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TUESDAY MEETING MINUTES May 8, 2012

1. At 9:02 a.m., Commissioner Wheeler declared the Tuesday meeting of the Polk County Board of Commissioners in session. Commissioner Pope was present, Commissioner Ainsworth was excused.

2. MOTION: COMMISSIONER POPE MOVED, COMMISSIONER WHEELER SECONDED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF MAY 1, 2012.

3. CIVIL RIGHTS SELF ASSESSMENT

Randi Phillips, Public Health Manager reported on the county-wide civil rights assessment that she recently completed as part of the Public Health Department's triennial review. Overall, the County is doing a good job; it is compliant with most of the ADA aspects of the review, but there are areas to improve upon regarding communication formats for non-English speakers; including updating the website to include alternative language options and updating building signage. Randi recommends that either each department or the County as a whole adopt policies for the practices that are already in place to be compliant with the Civil Rights assessment.

a. SECRETARY OF STATE 'AT-RISK' COUNTY REPORT

Greg Hansen, Administrative Officer and Linda Fox, Treasurer, received a draft report from the Secretary of State Audit Division that details the seven most 'Atrisk' counties in Oregon, including Polk County. All of the counties featured are counties that heavily relied on O&C funding. The report requested that Polk County respond with how we are handling the economic distress.
