- 1. At 9:02 a.m., Commissioner Pope declared the Tuesday meeting of the Polk County Board of Commissioners in session. Commissioner Wheeler and Commissioner Ainsworth were present.

- 3. <u>RECLASSIFICATION</u> Matt Hawkins, Administrative Services Director, requested approval for Jennifer Segovia, who is currently an Office Specialist I, be reclassified as an Office Specialist II. The Board approved.
- 4. <u>SPEED STUDY</u> Todd Whitaker, Public Works Director, asked the Board how Public Works should handle speed study requests considering low patrol by Sheriff's Office and no/little enforcement. After discussion between the Board, Sheriff and Todd the Board recommended continuing with speed studies as the need arises.
- 5. **NON-LISTED ITEMS** (Pursuant to ORS 192.640, the Board of Commissioners considered the below identified non-listed items.)
 - a. <u>ORDINANCES</u> Morgan Smith, County Counsel, is working with the Sheriff to bring ordinances before the Board of Commissioners for policies already in place involving inventory searches.
 - b. <u>FOOD DRIVE</u> Commissioner Wheeler requested that the County still does a canned food drive even though there will not be a Holiday Luncheon this year. Board members concurred, and requested that employees be notified through the Communique to participate in their individual departments.
