17	WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Polk County, Oregon, is sworn to uphold
18	the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the state of Oregon; and
19	the constitution of the officer states and the constitution of the state of oregon, and
20	WHEREAS, the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution states that the
21	"right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed"; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, Article I, Section 27 of the Oregon State Constitution states that the
24	"people shall have the right to bear arms for the defense of themselves, and the State, but Military
25	shall be kept in strict subordination to the civil power;" and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Polk County, Oregon, recognizes that the
28	first and last protectors of the United States Constitution are the people of the United States, and
29 20	that the ability of the people to fulfill that role rests in large part on the peoples' right to bear arms
30 31	as stated in the Constitutions of the United States and the State of Oregon; and
32	WHEREAS, the criminal misuse of firearms by those in the criminal element is not a
33	reason to deny the Constitutional right to keep and bear arms by law-abiding citizens; and
34	Tousen to doing the constitutional right to neep and out arms by this distribution, and
35	WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of the United States in District of Columbia v. Heller
36	upheld the individual rights to bear arms as protected by the Second Amendment of the United
37	States Constitution with Justice Scalia's opinion stating that the Second Amendment protects an
38	individual's right to possess a firearm unconnected with service in a militia, and to use that
39	firearm for traditionally lawful purposes, such as self-defense within the home. Also, the United
40	States Supreme Court in McDonald v. Chicago, invalidated Chicago's handgun ban and held the
41	Second Amendment to the United States Constitution applies to the States; now, therefore:
42	VIOLED YEAR OLD THE PROPERTY OF THE PROPERTY O
43	IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT, Polk County opposes any state or federal law that
44 15	abridges or is contrary to the provisions of the United States Constitution and state of Oregon Constitution; and
45 46	Constitution, and
40 47	Polk County supports the right of the people to lawfully bear arms as stated in the Second
48	Amendment to the United States Constitution and the Oregon Constitution and opposes any state
49	or federal law that unconstitutionally restricts a citizen's right to bear arms.
