3. COMMENTS (FOR ITEMS NOT ON THIS AGENDA)

Bill Kluting, 16600 Cooper Hollow Road testified that earlier this year, he was driving on a steep hill near his home when he had an encounter with the swather (farm equipment). The road is 18 feet wide, the swather is 14 feet wide, so it was taking up most of both lanes of the road. Mr. Kluting was forced to reverse back down the hill, where he hit the vehicle behind him. By law, farm equipment does not require flaggers, but they also cannot impede oncoming traffic. Mr. Kluting encouraged the Board to write a letter to the farm equipment owner (Riddle) to encourage the use of a flag car when this equipment is moved in the future.
