Polk County Community Wildfire Protection Plan Public Input Encouraged!

Public comments are sought for the review of the Polk County Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP) Update.

The Polk County CWPP was collaboratively developed with stakeholders and emergency response personnel to improve wildfire preparedness and identify avenues for reducing risk throughout the county. The plan identifies wildfire risks throughout the County, with specific focus on the County's highly valued resources and assets (HVRAs) as well as the wildland-urban interface (WUI), which refers to the area between wildland and human development.

Public Review Period: September 1, 10:00 AM - September 15, 10:00 AM

During this period, Polk County invites residents to provide their feedback on the draft CWPP to ensure it meets the community's needs and effectively addresses public concerns. The CWPP will serve as a guiding document that will help Polk County and landowners make informed decisions and improve safety as it relates to potential wildfire risk.
