Willamina School District 30J

Measure No: 36-230

Caption: Bonds to Renovate, Improve Schools, Add Classrooms

Question: Shall Willamina School District 30J issue up to \$2,500,000 in principal amount of bonds for schools; receive \$2,500,000 matching grant? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary: District will receive 100% State matching grant of \$2,500,000 if bond measure is approved by voters. This measure would finance capital costs for the District, expected to include:

- providing five new classrooms to the main building;
- safety and security improvements, including to improve traffic congestion and pedestrian safety;
- expanding outdoor space to improve function and safety; and
- additional projects, including minor upgrades to facilities, furnishings, equipment, bond issuance costs.

The District will utilize a citizen oversight committee to ensure proceeds are used for purposes indicated and audits will be required.

Bonds may be issued in multiple series; each maturing within 10 years from issuance.

Due to existing bonds being paid off, the District estimates that this measure will result in a decrease to the District's bond tax rate to approximately \$0.49 per \$1,000 from \$0.53 per \$1,000 of assessed value. The actual levy rate for this measure may differ due to actual interest rates incurred and changes in assessed value.

West Valley Fire District

Measure No: 36-229

Caption: Five-Year Local Option Levy for Fire & EMS Operations

Question: Shall WVFD impose \$1.72 per \$1,000 of assessed value for fire and EMS for five-years beginning July 2024? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

Summary: This measure, if approved, would authorize West Valley Fire District (District) to levy taxes to support the annual cost of fire and emergency medical service operations. The measure would provide a local option levy at a rate of \$1.72 per \$1,000 of assessed value for five years, beginning July 1, 2024. This measure would replace the current levy that expires June 30, 2025.

The District is facing escalating costs of operation that were not anticipated with the current levy. Funds from this levy would be used to sustain current operations including maintaining the current contracted staffing.

The proposed levy rate would raise approximately \$643,014 in 2024-2025, \$662,305 in 2025-2026, \$682,174 in 2026-2027, \$702,639 in 2027-2028, \$723,719 in 2028-2029, for a total of \$3,413,851. The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY, based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time.
