POLK COUNTY FAIR CAMPING RULES

These rules have been put in place in accordance with **ORS 565.225** for safety purposes. Failure to abide by these rules may result in immediate eviction from the camp area, and could result in exclusion from the camping area during future Fairs.

- Campers, trailers, tents etc. Must be in place by 10:00pm Wednesday August 10th. Set up days are Sun. Aug. 7th – Wed. Aug. 10th.
- 2. Vehicles must be parked in camp area or in 4-H/FFA parent parking. Any vehicle parked in the fire lanes will be towed at the owners expense any vehicle not parked properly will be towed at the owner expense.
- 3. Speed limit is 5 MPH in the camping area, parking area and roadway into Nesmith Park, violators will loose their ability to camp.
- 4. A camping bracelet must be worn by all overnight campers, or you will be asked to leave at curfew.
- 5. Dogs and other pets are not allowed on the grounds or campsites.
- 6. Youth campers must have a chaperone, the chaperone must be registered with the fair office.
- 7. Curfew is at 11:00pm Thursday & Friday. Midnight on Saturday. Quite time is 10:00pm –7:00am daily. Arena lights and barn lights must be off by 10:30pm
- 8. Nesmith Park entrance will be opened to people with the appropriate passes.
- 9. You must clean up your camping area before leaving; all garbage must be put <u>in</u> <u>the big dumpsters at the fence line</u>. Do not leave garbage in your camping area.

The Polk County Fair Board has worked very hard with other County entities to continue the tradition and privilege of overnight parking for our 4-H/FFA exhibitors. Please help us keep this tradition alive for future 4-H/FFA exhibitors by obeying the rules that have been put in place for the safety of everyone on the fairgrounds.

Help keep the grounds and park clean. If you see garbage on the grounds **PICK IT UP AND THROW IT IN A GARBAGE CAN.**

Lessee shall save and hold harmless lessor, Polk County and their employees and agents jointly, severally and privately and defend the same from all claims of damage, suits and action of every kind arising out of lessee's occupancy of use of the premises or property.

I have read, understand and will abide by these rules, and will make all campers in my campsite aware of these rules.
