- If participants plan on leaving their medication in its original container you are encouraged to remove any identifying information from the prescription label by either removing the label or utilizing a permanent marker.
- All solid dosage pharmaceutical products and liquids in consumer containers will be accepted.
- Liquid products, such as cough syrup, must remain sealed in their original container.

*** Intra-venous solutions, injectables, syringes, sharps, chemotherapy medications, or medical waste <u>WILL NOT</u> be accepted due to their potential hazard posed by blood-borne pathogens ***
