EBDM	Marty Silbernagel stated Polk County was selected as one of the counties selected by the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission. He explained there would be five states selected by the National Institute of Corrections (NIC). The selection will be made near the end of November and NIC will be ready to start working with counties in January 2015.	Information
Measure 91	The committee discussed strategies to address Measure 91which legalizes Marijuana. Matthew Stevenson stated Prevention will address marijuana as a health issue. Aaron Felton explained that law enforcement will have many more marijuana related events such as impaired driving. He is concerned about children having access to marijuana and that no one has addressed the health issues of marijuana use. The group was also concerned about ingestible marijuana falling into the hands of children who were unaware that there was marijuana in the food item. Marty asked the group what prevention efforts could be made and or/supported by the LAPPC. Suggestions included education classes at the schools, a Victim's Impact Panel for youth, and making sure youth understand that marijuana is still illegal for them. Education classes should have a prevention component similar to those provided about tobacco and alcohol. Presentations by sports figures may also be effective. Recommendations were that Marty Silbernagel, Jen Mason and Commission Ainsworth request to meet with Central School District Superintendent, Buzz Brazeau, to discuss the possibility of providing prevention education in the Central school district.
