14	WHEREAS, The applications for PA 18-01 and ZC 18-02 were submitted on		
15	December 14, 2018; and		
16	WHEREAS, On October 8, 2019, Staff included in the record their Staff Report and		
17	conclusion, based on the evidence in the record, that the application does not comply with all of		
18	the applicable review and decision criteria; and		
19	WHEREAS, On October 15, 2019 a public hearing was conducted before the Hearings		
20	Officer, with due notice of the public hearing having been given, and an opportunity was		
21	provided for public comments and testimony. There were no objections as to notice or		
22	jurisdiction. The Hearings Officer allowed all parties to be heard and to submit an unlimited		
23	amount of written materials. On June 1, 2019 the Hearings Officer issued a recommendation to		
24	the Board of Commissioners to deny the applications, included as Exhibit B; and		

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners held a public hearing on July 22, 2020, with due notice of the public hearing having been given, and they provided an opportunity for public comments and testimony. There were no objections as to notice or jurisdiction. The Board allowed all parties to be heard and to submit an unlimited amount of written materials. At the public hearing, the Board announced that additional evidence could be submitted into the record until August 5, 2020 at 5:00 P.M.; rebuttal of any evidence that was submitted during the two-week open record period could be submitted until August 12, 2020 at 5:00 P.M.; and final arguments by the Applicants could be submitted until August 19, 2020 at 5:00 P.M. at which time the record closed. A deliberation date of October 7, 2020 was announced at the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, On October 7, 2020 at the scheduled deliberation, Polk County's Legal Counsel announced that ex parte communication occurred on September 26, 2020, when a constituent individually contacted Commissioner Mordhorst and commented on this matter after the record was closed. A transcript of the communication was provided and Commissioner Ainsworth and Commissioner Pope moved to re-open the record to allow additional testimony to be submitted into the record in response to the ex parte communication. A rescheduled deliberation date was announced for December 9, 2020; and

WHEREAS, On October 14, 2020 staff sent notice to all interested parties specifying a new open record period timeline. Additional evidence could be submitted into the record between October 15, 2020 and October 22, 2020 at 5:00 P.M. to rebut the content of the ex
