

Spirit Mountain Community Grants - Open Now

Please check out the following information about the Spirit Mountain Community Fund grant processes:

- We have two grant processes that run quarterly Small and Large. Each process has two stages LOI and application. Our Board of Trustees chooses which projects will progress from the Letter of Inquiry stage to the application stage.
- Small grant applicants can apply for up to \$7500. Large grant applicants can apply for up to \$50,000 for programmatic projects and up to \$100,000 for capital projects.
- Our next Small grant LOI deadline is on 12/4/23, and our next Large grant LOI deadline is on 1/8/24.
- The first Thursday of each month, we host an online grant workshop, explaining all of our processes in detail.


PATHS - 5 Year Strategic Plan


